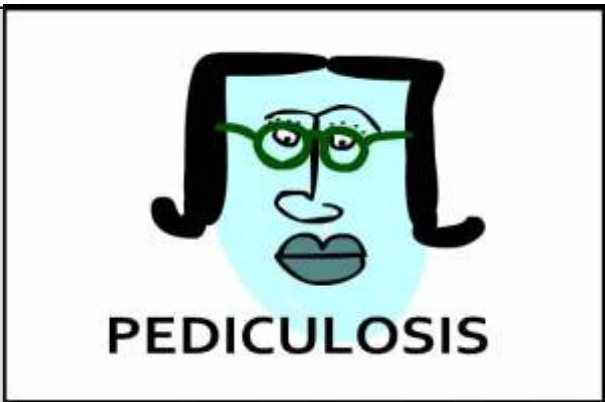
mtn's fresh faces
