

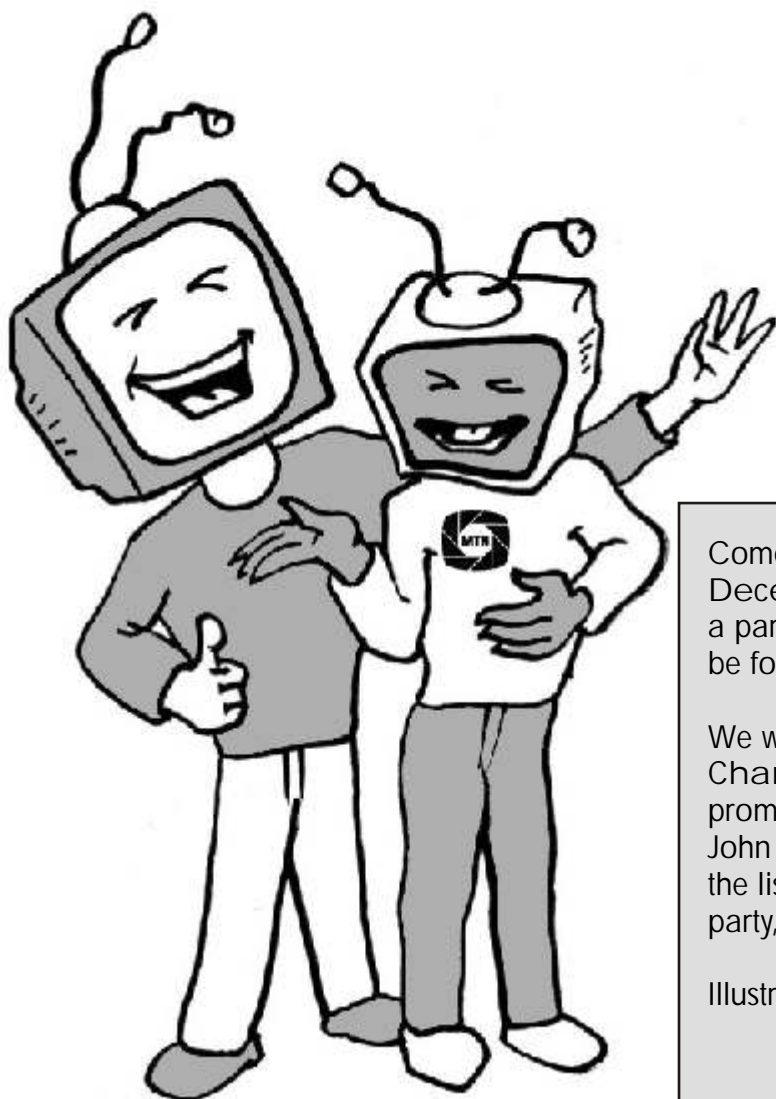

meet the 20th class of video voices

In 1989, MTN and South High began partnering on a program called **Video Voices**, a high school class that combined English and Social Studies with video production. This year, the 20th class of Video Voices students (above) is settling in to its work creating Public Service Announcements, documentaries, and other productions with the help of MTN.

A new twist this year is **Chris Nordenson**, who comes to MTN from the Community Technology Empowerment Project (CTEP) branch of Americorps, a national service program. Chris is serving at MTN this year to help us enhance our Youth Media programs. He brings his skills as a recent graduate of the Broadcast Journalism program at the University of St. Thomas to the Voices students and other youth coming to MTN.

“The kids are energetic and excited about the program. They realize that there are not a lot of programs like this, so they are lucky to have this opportunity to make videos to express their ideas about issues in our society,” Nordenson said.

Chris is assisted by **Hamil Griffin-Cassidy** and **John Akre**, who each have been helping out with

Voices for at least ten years. At South High, **Neil Anderson**, the Social Studies teacher, and **Suekehr**, the English teacher, work with the students day to day during the class's two hour session.

The 51 South High students in this year's class are not only building video production skills, they are learning about how media tools influence the world, and, maybe, a little bit about society itself. That the Voices program has been around for twenty years is a testament both to the partnership between MTN and South High, and to the influence of the program on its students.

“I think that it shows how strong the program is, and we just want to keep on improving it and making it the best program it can be. That it has been around twenty years is very impressive, and I am proud to be a part of it,” Nordenson said.
